Intended Use

This single patient use blanket is designed to be used with a Stryker Hyper/Hypothermia machine having Medi-Therm Colder connector hoses. Maximum benefit to patient at the greatest margin of safety requires a thorough knowledge and understanding of the correct operation and application of the machine. Refer to the Medi-Therm operations manual prior to use.



⚠ WARNING

- To avoid the risk of patient injury, at least every 20 minutes, or as directed by a physician, check patient's temperature and skin condition of areas in contact with blanket. Also, check blanket water temperature.
- Risk of cross-contamination (e.g. Infection, allergic reaction). Product is for single patient use.

Note:

- Sharp objects in contact with blanket may cause tears.
- Using pins to secure blanket may cause leakage.
- Hose clamps must be open to operate machine.
- Patient can be positioned directly on nonwoven surface. No sheet is required.

Operating Procedures

- 1. Close the pinch clamps on the connector hose and Strvker blanket.
- 2. Attach the connector hoses to the machine. (See machine operating instructions.)
- 3. Attach the connector hoses to the blankets.
 - Insert male fittings of blanket into female fittings of hose. Press until click is heard.
 - When fittings are fully inserted, pull lightly to assure connectors are locked.
- 4. Open all clamps on the connector hose and the blanket.
- 5. Insert the power cord into ground receptacle. Turn machine on. Check that the blanket is filled. Refer to the Medi-Therm Operations Manual.

Cleaning Instructions

Clean product with soap and water. Wipe dry. Do not use solvents or alcohol.


Disconnecting Instructions

- Turn off the machine and allow most of the water to drain back into the machine (approximately 10 minutes).
- 2. Close blanket clamps.
- 3. Press release on hose connectors to disconnect blanket.
- 4. Discard blanket after use (per hospital protocol).

Note:

Do not discard machine connector hose after use. save for next use.
