<u>CAUTION</u>: This chair has moving parts that may create pinch points. Work or cleaning should be performed only in the upright position with the chair latched or in the full recline position. Keep your hands clear of the mechanism when moving the chair from one position to another.

- 1. Assemble your tools and move the chair to your chosen work area.
- 2. Lock the casters, a carpeted work area is suggested.
- 3. Identify the foley-hook to be replaced on either side of the chair.
- 4. Use a #8 square bit and impact gun to remove the 2 wood screws (SC-81WD) securing the foley-hook to the arm.
- 5. Discard the foley-hook and hardware removed in step 4.
- 6. Place replacement foley-hook (002117) in the same location, verify that the hook is in the upright position.
- 7. Use a #8 square bit and impact gun to secure the foley-hook to the arm using 2 replacement wood screws (SC-81WD).
- 8. Verify the foley hook is secure and functional—the replacement unit should not be loose.
- 9. Repeat steps 3-7 for the other side if applicable.
